Credit union to host forum about retirement savings

Internationally recognized retirement speaker and author **Diane McCurdy** will discuss retirement savings with school employees Sept. 30 at the Plummer Auditorium at 201 E. Chapman Ave. from 9 a.m. to noon.

Her discussion is part of a half-day retirement forum hosted by the Orange County Teachers' Federal Credit Union, a credit union for school employees, at no cost to school employees and their spouses.

Although school employees automatically contribute 7 to 8 percent of their salary to state retirement funds through CalSTRS or CalPERS, many experts say that will not be enough. They will actually need 70 to 80 percent of their current salary to maintain their standard of living in retirement.

More than 7,600 OCTFCU members, including nearly 2,200 school employees, live in San Bernardino County. This fall, the group will open three branches in San Bernardino County.
